GRACE GIVES ADVANTAGE

To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ.

— Ephesians 3:8

Grace is divine support for the assignment God has given you. Paul said that grace gave him the advantage to preach the unsearchable riches of Christ to the Gentiles.

Perhaps you have been praying and praying over certain situations — but what you truly need is grace.

Grace lifts you. Grace colours you. Grace increases you. Grace multiplies you.

You can direct the grace of God toward specific areas of your life:

- ◆ I direct the grace of God in this direction.
- ◆ I direct the grace of God upon my work.
- ◆ I direct the grace of God upon my business.

Perhaps you have a business but there are no customers — direct the grace of God upon your business.

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.

— 2 Corinthians 9:8

God is able to make all grace abound toward you — in abundant form — so that you always have all sufficiency in all things.

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

— Hebrews 4:16

Christ Embassy is the throne of grace. This church is the throne of grace. Every time you come to church, carry this knowledge with you:

I am coming to receive mercy and all the grace I need for my affairs.

When you invite someone, say: "Let us go and receive grace." When someone asks where you are going — say: "I am going to receive grace."

He did not say we should come to beg for mercy — He said to come boldly and obtain mercy, find grace: mercy, favour, grace, and help.

RECEIVE GRACE

What difficulty do you have in your life? You have already come to the throne — you can receive your grace right here. Come boldly and declare:

- ◆ I receive grace for my studies.
- ◆ I receive grace for my health.
- ◆ I receive grace for my business.
- ◆ I receive grace for my work.

When you receive this — go back with joy. Do not return the same way you came.

Say it:

I receive grace. I receive grace for this week.

Grace is the solution to everything. The grace of God strengthens me.

PROCLAMATION

It does not matter what is happening with the economy. It does not matter what the weather looks like. When others are falling, you will declare:

I am a victor. Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world.

This is your month of advancement. You will make advancement through grace. Some of you will testify of advancement every single week — and it will be through grace.

Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain! And he shall bring forth the capstone with shouts of Grace, grace to it!

— Zechariah 4:7

Zerubbabel has gone to heaven, but there is a new Zerubbabel here. Put your name in the place of Zerubbabel — because the Word of God is eternal. Say:

Who are you, O great mountain, before me? You are a plain! Grace! Grace! Grace!

This week, people will ask you: "How did you do that?" — and you will say: "Grace. Grace." This is my new life. Grace is how my life works now.

It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; for there the Lord commanded the blessing — life forevermore.

— Psalm 133:3

There where God commanded the blessing — not blessings, but one blessing that opens every door. Grace for everything. Grace makes everything work. The grace of God does not need the economy's permission to

operate. The grace of God makes people great. The grace of God creates kings. All you need is an abundance of grace.

But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.

— James 4:6

He gives more grace. Let this be your prayer every morning:

Thank You, Jesus. I receive more grace. I leave full of grace. I have grace for everything I want to do.
