



BE FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT

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THE OUTPOURING CONTINUES

Last week, Pastor shared a profound Scripture on the outpouring of the Spirit. When you are filled with the Spirit, your dryness becomes a fruitful field — confusion goes, debt goes, every curse that has been a constant in your life becomes a walkover.

Until the spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest.

— Isaiah 32:15 (KJV)

It is impossible to be broke when you are filled with the Spirit.

When you are full of the Spirit, you live an extraordinary, supernatural Christian life. The wilderness becomes a fruitful field, and the fruitful field is counted for a forest.

But someone might say: I have received the Holy Ghost. I speak in tongues. Why am I not seeing results? Because you are not filled with the Spirit every day. You come to church, you are charged, you say this week will be amazing — and then your teacher talks down on you, your boss challenges you, and your faith goes down.

The answer is to be continually filled with the Spirit.

HOW TO BE FILLED DAILY

And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

— Ephesians 5:18 (KJV)

Notice the semicolon after the Spirit. The verse does not end there. When you see a semicolon, the thought continues. Being filled is not a one-time event — it is a continuous action. Be being filled. Every single day.

Here are three ways to be filled with the Spirit daily:

WAY 1 — SPEAKING TO YOURSELF IN PSALMS

Ephesians 5:19 continues: speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs. This is how you stay filled. You pull out scriptures and speak them to yourself. Not to another person — to yourself.

Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly... he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

— Psalm 1:1–3 (KJV)

Declare it in the now:

I am a tree planted by the rivers of water. I bring forth fruit in my season. Whatever I do prospers — not shall prosper. It prospers now.

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures... Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil... Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life.

— Psalm 23 (KJV)

Your bank account shows 200 roubles. Rent is due. School fees are due. What do you do? You go to your room and get filled with the Spirit. You say: Father, in the name of Jesus, the Lord is my shepherd — I shall not want. You say it until you begin to see yourself that way.

I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy testimonies are my meditation.

— Psalm 119:99 (KJV)

That teacher says you know nothing. Your lecturer is trying to terrorize you. Go back to your room and say: I have more understanding than my teachers. Say it until you see yourself that way.

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

— 3 John 1:2 (KJV)

You are not asking for healing — you are walking in health. Declare: I walk in divine health. I walk in prosperity. The word is my meditation.

That ye might be filled with all the fullness of God.

— Ephesians 3:19 (KJV)

Being filled with the fullness of God is the same as being filled with the Spirit. The conveyor of God's presence is the Holy Ghost. The Bible also says that in Jesus Christ dwells the fullness of the Godhead — and you are completing Him. You are full of God.

WAY 2 — PRAYING WITH GROANINGS

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

At times you are praying and you find yourself groaning. At times you find yourself crying for no natural reason. The Spirit of God has taken over. Out of your belly shall flow rivers of living water.

When that happens, you know that all things will work together for your good. You will show up somewhere and they will say: we were just talking about you — you are the answer we needed. That is deep calling unto deep. The Spirit of God is channeling things to you, guiding you to the right place at the right time.

When you are filled with the Spirit, you cannot be in the wrong place at the wrong time.

WAY 3 — PRAYING IN THE HOLY GHOST

But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost.

— Jude 1:20 (KJV)

Praying in tongues activates your spirit. Your spirit becomes attuned to the Spirit of God immediately. When you pray in tongues, listen — the Spirit is giving you answers, giving you solutions, telling you where to go and who to meet.

He will tell you who to meet for the job. He will tell you who to meet for the business. He will tell you who the deal-breaker is. Your spirit is sensitive to the Spirit of God — let your spirit work with the Spirit of God.

When you find yourself in a mess, in a situation you cannot get out of — start praying in tongues. The Spirit of God will show you what to do.

THE KEY TO AN EXTRAORDINARY LIFE

Imagine you were given a key that could open every door in Russia — even the Kremlin, even every vault. You would sleep with that key. You would never let it go.

Being filled with the Spirit is that key. It is the key to an unending, victorious, and successful Christian life.

The Christian life moves in only one direction — upward and forward. There is no down life. It does not matter what circumstances say. Do not be a circumstantial Christian who is only smiling when things are good.

When you are filled with the Holy Ghost and pulling out scriptures, you become rich with God's Word. You must have a rich asset of God's Word. If you do not know that the Bible says you have more understanding than your teachers — how will you declare it? You must know those scriptures.

This is also meditation on the Spirit. There is meditation on the Word — reading, speaking it out. But there is a higher place: meditation on the Spirit. When you do it, you will live an extraordinary Christian life.

In this month of prayer, build up your daily confessions. Hear a message, read Rhapsody of Realities, and build your declarations. Write them. Say them every day. The impossible will be made possible. Keep saying it — it may take time, but keep saying it.

- ◆ I am a tree planted by rivers of water. Whatever I do prospers.

CLOSING DECLARATION

The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. I fear no evil. The Lord is the strength of my life.

I am a victor. I have no fear in me. I am full of God. I am full of the Holy Ghost. I have the life of God in me. My mind is alert. My spirit is energized.

I am a success — 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. I am not a failure. I walk in favour everywhere. I am making giant strides by the Holy Ghost.

In my path is life. In my path there is no failure. In my path is victory, dominion, fruitfulness, and overflow of prosperity.

I am full of God. I live in dominion. In the name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

PRAYER OF SALVATION

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

— Romans 10:9 (KJV)
