



UNTIL THE SPIRIT IS POURED

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THE OUTPOURING

Today is the very last day of the month of May — the month of advancements. We are advancing powerfully. We are advancing miraculously. We are advancing by the Spirit of God.

I am advancing. I am making progress. I am moving forward by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The Bible speaks about the outpouring of God's Spirit upon the world. In Isaiah 32, the prophet spoke in expectation of what the Spirit of God would do when He came. When the Holy Ghost came on the Day of Pentecost, everything the prophet said He would do must be evidently seen in your life.

We are not Christians in words only. We are Christians in deeds and actions. Our lives testify. Our minds testify. Our bodies testify. Our spirits testify — and our pockets will testify, as the Spirit has spoken.

Isaiah 32 describes a picture of dryness, barrenness, and lamentation — a city that should have been joyful but was full of trouble. An empty place. A forsaken palace. A beautiful edifice overgrown with weeds. No movement forward.

Maybe that is your situation. January, February, March, April, May — and you have not yet seen the progress you heard about. Lamentation arises. You begin to wonder: what is going on?

Until the spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest.

— Isaiah 32:15 (KJV)

That is the answer. Until the Holy Ghost shows up, nothing will change. But when the Spirit is poured upon us from on high, the wilderness becomes fruitful. The presence of the Holy Ghost is about fruitfulness.

Have you received the Holy Ghost? Then your life must be fruitful.

Notice the phrase: "until it is poured." This is not a drop — it is an outpouring, a process. A cup is one thing. A bucket is another. A hose is something else entirely. When the Spirit is poured on you, the quantity matters.

The outpouring of the Spirit brings a change of location. If you are in the wilderness, He will place you in the fruitful field. If you are already in the fruitful field, He will translate you into the forest. Change is certain. He makes you fruitful, then takes you from fruitfulness into overflow.

You came from a dry place, but you are not leaving here dry. You are leaving here wet.

THE LAW OF THE NEW LOCATION

And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever.

— Isaiah 32:17 (KJV)

Peace. Shalom. Tranquility on every side. That is the law of the new location. The blessing of the Lord maketh rich and addeth no sorrow. It produces peace on all sides.

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

— Romans 8:28 (KJV)

The work of righteousness is peace, and the effect of righteousness is quietness and assurance forever. That builds your confidence. You are assured that tomorrow will be okay. No panicking, no running. That is the effect of righteousness in you.

When others are panicking and asking "what is going on?" — you are at peace. You are like Jesus sleeping in the boat. That is the confidence of the Spirit.

When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up; and he shall save the humble person.

— Job 22:29 (KJV)

And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

— Psalm 1:3 (KJV)

While others say there is a casting down, you say there is a lifting up. Whatever you touch works. Righteousness is the nature of God — His ability to be right at all times. The same Spirit of righteousness in you will make you say "I am rich," and you will be rich. It happens according to your word.

FILLED WITH THE HOLY GHOST

Peter and John healed a man lame from birth at the gate called Beautiful. When the people were amazed, Peter declared it was not by their power but by the name of Jesus. They were arrested and told to stop speaking in that name — but Peter answered boldly. These things were not done in a corner. We are witnesses of His majesty.

And being let go, they went to their own company...

— Acts 4:23 (KJV)

That is important — you need to have a company. If you are surrounded by complainers, change your location. They went to their own company and told their story. Spirit-filled people do not panic. They lifted their voice and prayed.

Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is.

— Acts 4:24 (KJV)

And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word. By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

— Acts 4:29–30 (KJV)

And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

— Acts 4:31 (KJV)

That was the answer. The Spirit of God is God's answer. You ask God for something, and He gives you His Spirit. His Spirit is His answer. What they asked for, they received when they were filled with the Holy Ghost. That is an outpouring. That is a change of location.

See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is. And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit.

— Ephesians 5:15–18 (KJV)

Be filled with the Holy Spirit. Do not have Him in only one corner of your life — let Him be full. That brings you into the new location and into overflow. Righteousness becomes the law of your life.

Paul and Silas were in prison, but they were full. The Holy Ghost came down, the gates were broken, the chains were broken, and they moved to a new location. Peter was in prison, but the church prayed. They were full. An angel was sent, and Peter's location was changed — released by the power of the Holy Ghost.

You cannot stay stagnant for too long when you are full of the Holy Ghost. It is an error.

THE FULLNESS OF THE MOST HIGH

He is called the Most High. He dwells where He cannot be compared. Now imagine when you are full of the Most High. Can you stay down? If you are full of the Most High and He comes into you, you cannot remain down.

He dwells in a light which no man can approach unto. He defines the sun. The sun bows. Intense brightness. The origin of light. When you are full of Him, you cannot remain in darkness, and you cannot remain down. We have not activated this enough in our mindset.

That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power.

— Ephesians 1:17–19 (KJV)

Paul prayed that your eyes of understanding would be enlightened, so that you would know the exceeding greatness of His power available to us. It is like the fire hose of a fire truck — that is what has been given to you. We are not weak. We are not small. There is power in you.

Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come.

— Ephesians 1:20–21 (KJV)

That power is powerful today, powerful yesterday, and powerful in the world to come. It is power that remains relevant forever. Finally — be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armour of God. And keep the armour working by praying always in the Spirit.

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

— Romans 8:26–27 (KJV)

That is the process of the outpouring. You are praying and groaning, and He is getting full. When you are full, the mind of the Spirit is what is communicated through your tongues. You are speaking, but His mind is what God is hearing. Then comes assurance. Quietness. Confidence. You just know it will turn out right.

We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak.

— 2 Corinthians 4:13 (KJV)

Faith is the assurance in our hearts — the confident assurance of what we hope for. Every trouble you face now, every challenge you face now, it will turn out right for those who love Him and are called according to His purpose.

DECLARATIONS & CLOSING

The Spirit of God has broken up your fallow ground. Now that you are full, speak forth what you desire:

- ◆ Increase everywhere. Prosperity everywhere. Strength everywhere.
- ◆ Fruitfulness everywhere. Speed everywhere. No more delay.
- ◆ I walk in the overflow — overflow of faith, favour, and strength.

Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

— Psalm 35:27 (KJV)

To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

— Isaiah 61:3 (KJV)

The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing.

— Psalm 92:12–14 (KJV)

In the name of our Lord Jesus — you have changed location. The outpouring of the Spirit changes your location. What can you see? As far as your eyes can see, it is yours.

Today is the last day of May. By midnight tonight we move into a new month. It is time to move forward. There is still more land to cover. There is still more to take over. You have already moved — not by power nor by might, but by the Spirit.

The LORD bless you and keep you.

The LORD make His face shine upon you and give you peace on all sides.
